- I. Purpose:
To ensure that seclusion is used in CMHA network hospitals, centers or licensed child-caring institutions in accordance with all applicable state and federal regulations.
- II. Policy:
Seclusion will only be used in a hospital or center or licensed child-caring institution Use of Seclusion is prohibited in all other settings.
- III. Responsibilities:
The Medical Director is responsible for ensuring that procedures to implement the intent of this policy are developed, reviewed, and revised as necessary.
- IV. Monitoring and review:
This policy is reviewed by the Medical Director. It is monitored internally by quality improvement committees, and the Recipient Rights Office. It is monitored externally by the Department of Community Health, and CARF.
