The Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, Ingham Counties Board of Directors authorize CMHA-CEI to enter into a renewal contract with the Regents of the University of Michigan to purchase tele-psychiatry services: psychiatric assessments (\$275.00 per event) and consultation/medication reviews (\$127.00 per event) and be reimbursed for those services for the retroactive period of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021.

Ericanne Spence said the contracts she is presenting to the committee tonight have been in existence for 2-3 years and there have been no changes.

# Revenue Contract Renewal: Peckham, Inc.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Board of Directors of Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, and Ingham Counties approve the following resolution:

The Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, Ingham Counties Board of Directors authorize CMHA-CEI to renew the contract with Peckham, Inc., which establishes mutual understanding about the transfer of the funds, as stated below, for the retroactive period of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021.

- A. CMHA-CEI will pay \$76,000.00 to the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity Michigan Rehabilitation Services (MRS) for cash match purposes (known as the Interagency Cash Transfer Agreement (ICTA) payment) toward the Supported Employment Program (SEP).
- B. Peckham, Inc. will reimburse CMHA-CEI \$26,780 within 30 days of MRS' receipt of payment.
- C. Peckham, Inc. will reimburse CMHA-CEI \$12,305.00 on a quarterly basis, with payments due by the last day of the quarter (December 31, March 31, June 30, and September 30), for a total reimbursement of \$49,220.00 during the contract period.
- D. CMHA-CEI will provide a designated staff liaison for SEP to ensure enough job ready referrals (75 for the year) are generated for SEP in order to meet the annual program performance goals.

# **Expense Contract Amendment: Flatrock Manor, Inc.**

This contract amendment adds a one-to-one staffing support when needed. Both CSDD and AMHS use this provider. Kay asked what is bringing about the change with the one-on-one supports? Karla said Flatrock supports some of our most challenging cases, and sometimes a case will go above and beyond Flatrock's capabilities, which is where the one-on-one support comes in. Kay asked if we shouldn't have already had this language within the contract as a basic provision, and then it would only be activated as there is a need? She wondered if this is because a specialized determination that the one-on-one services are needed? Karla said the standard boilerplate language does not include one-on-one levels of care because these are rare circumstances. Stacia agreed this is a rarity, and sometimes this is built into a rate, with the rate negotiated to account for any one-on-one care. She isn't sure if it would be appropriate to open this up to every provider, as it may open too many opportunities for potentially overstaffing a consumer.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Board of Directors of Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, and Ingham Counties approve the following resolution:

The Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, Ingham Counties Board of Directors authorize CMHA-CEI to renew the contract with Peckham, Inc., which establishes mutual understanding about the transfer of the funds, as stated below, for the retroactive period of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021.

- A. CMHA-CEI will pay \$61,811 to the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity Michigan Rehabilitation Services (MRS) for cash match purposes (known as the Interagency Cash Transfer Agreement (ICTA) payment) toward the Community Work Experience Program (CWEP).
- B. Peckham, Inc. will contribute \$24,000 to CMHA-CEI toward this initial cash match contribution of \$61,811. After CMHA-CEI makes the payment of \$61,811 to MRS, Peckham, Inc. will reimburse CMHA-CEI \$24,000 within 30 days of MRS' receipt of payment.
- C. Peckham, Inc. will reimburse CMHA-CEI \$9,452.75 on a quarterly basis, with payments due by the last day of the quarter (December 31, March 31, June 30, and September 30), for a total reimbursement of \$37, 811 during the contract period.
- D. CMHA-CEI will provide a designated staff liaison for CWEP to ensure enough job ready referrals (75 for the year) are generated for CWEP in order to meet the annual program performance goals.

# Revenue Contract Renewal: Veterans System of Care Grant – Michigan Department of Health and Human Services

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Board of Directors of Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, and Ingham Counties approve the following resolution:

The Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, Ingham Counties Board of Directors authorize CMHA-CEI to enter into a renewal contract with the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services to provide clinical group therapy, peer support services and client service specialist services to Veterans under the Veterans System of Care Grant to MDHHS for the retroactive period of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021 and receive \$200,000.

Expense Contract Renewals: Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) Donated Funds Agreements (DFA) - Eligibility Specialist Stacia Chick said this is also a long-standing contract with MDHHS. The only difference between previous years' contracts is that staff will no longer need to be located at the Jolly Road building. The specialists do not normally come into contact with many consumers at CEI, but they will be able to come to the building if needed. This is partially due to the Finance department going remote and the space being occupied by Families Forward in the near future.

The Board of Directors of Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, and Ingham Counties approve the following resolution:

The Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, Ingham Counties Board of Directors authorize CMHA-CEI to enter into an expense contract renewal with Michigan Department of Health and Human Services to purchase Eligibility Specialist services and pay up to \$66,700 for 1.0FTE and \$33,350 for .5FTE Eligibility Specialist positions for the retroactive period of October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021.
