#### Mid-State Health Network (MSHN) Update:

Board Member, Joe Brehler reported that the MSHN Board of Directors met. The \$868million-dollar budget was the focus of the meeting; reporting a \$16-million-dollar deficit, internal funds will be used to cover the short fall. Additionally, MSHN is anticipating decrease in Healthy MI funding for mental health and Substance Use Disorders (SUD); with a \$43-million-dollar increase in CMH expenses which includes CCBHC expenses.

### Crisis Stabilization Unit

Development Agreement from the McLaren Development Group was sent to CMHA-CEI Attorney for review yesterday. Sue Panetta, CFO is our point person with the attorney while it is under review and will involve John Peiffer and I in communications. It is unclear to me today, if a separate agreement has been sent to Ingham County.

Kudos to the QCSRR Prevention & Outreach staff and the many volunteers from across the organization or planning the CMHA-CEI day at the Zoo that was held in late August. It was a beautiful and very well attended event, with approximately 3,000 attendees

#### Walk A Mile in My Shoes Rally

The rally was held at the State Capitol. I was unable to attend but also would like to recognize our staff who were present to volunteer and who accompanied individuals we serve so they could participate in this important event.

Discussion ensued regarding a statement that was made by the CAC members of not feeling safe and the response allegedly provided by the Board liaison regarding an adopted policy that prevented CAC from meeting at a venue other than 812 E. Jolly when/if CAC meetings resumed to in-person. Board liaison inquired as to whether meeting at a location other than 812 E. Jolly was a want or need?

CEO, Sara Lurie cleared up the misconception that there was an existing policy that had been adopted, and stated that the CAC recommendations will be reviewed; including the concern regarding feeling safe at the 812 E. Jolly Road location and the matter of identifying an off-site venue for CAC meetings.

Board Member, Interim Chair, Joe Brehler clarified that there is no policy and pointed out that the Board liaison's response was not on behalf of the board, but rather a personal inquiry as to whether this request was a want or need and dismissed any further discussion.

ACTION: Recommendations from the CAC/Board Dialogue meetings will be brought back to the CMHA-CEI Board of Directors for review and further discussion.

#### **Community Access Committee**

Committee Chair, Diane Holman reported that the Monday, September 25<sup>th</sup> meeting has been canceled. The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, November 27th at 5:30 pm in the Atrium, located at 812 E. Jolly Road. At that time, the committee is planning to transfer the fifteen barriers that were identified into policies and continue discussion.

### Public Comment

Sharon Taylor, OPEIU, Local 459, President (Large, Residential, RN) thanked the CMHA-CEI Board of Directors, Chief Human Resources Officer, Jana Baylis and the entire negotiations team (Gwenda Summers, Families Forward Director, and Joanne Holland, Chief Information System Officer) for the time, effort and hard work invested over the last several months to negotiate the tentative agreement language that will be presented this evening and urged the Board to consider approving the agreements, stating that they are fair agreements. Ms. Taylor shared that it was a pleasure to step in following the resignation of Ben Curl, OPEIU Local 459 chief negotiator based on my long standing history with the organization, which started October 12, 1981, she is very familiar with CMHA-CEI, and over the years she shared that she has come to love the agency. Ms. Taylor also shared that she plans to retire in the near future. Ms. Taylor reported that over 30% of the membership had already voted, and she is hoping for about 65%. However, she is confident that it will pass. Ms. Taylor shared that member are able to vote electronically on in-person. The union will be located in the 812 E. Jolly Road lobby on Friday, September 22. The Union will present the Tentative Agreements for ratification to the membership, assuming the Union will ratify the amendments **by close of business**.

Chief Human Resources Officer, Jana Baylis thanked Sharon Taylor for stepping in and announced that the 512 Supervisors, and Physicians ratified earlier in the week.

Elizabeth Pratt, NAMI announced the following event is free and open to the public: Mental Illness Awareness Week 2023 Before the Mental Health Crisis: Assisted Outpatient Treatment Wednesday, October 4, 2023, from 7:00 to 8:30 pm Hannah Community Center, 819 Abbot Road, East Lansing

Luna Brown (She/her), expounded on the difference between Peer Support ad Peer Specialists claiming disparities. Additionally, she shared how Peer Mentors have made her feel less than; stating that Peer Supports are not allowed to transport, are unable to get hours, and are not viewed as highly or afforded the same rights and privileges. Also commented that she has spent more time on the bus than actually working with the clients, and requested an evaluation for consideration of an adjustment for fair treatment on the Mental Illness versus the Substance Use Disorder side.
