Skills Required:

Volunteer must be interested in working with adults with developmental disabilities. Must have the ability to self initiate organizing a project from beginning to end, with staff assistance as needed; ability to adjust projects for the abilities of the consumers participating and engage with them.

Other Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Police clearance check.
- Two TB test within the first two weeks of Orientation
- Ability to sit, stand and occasionally lift boxes up to 25 pounds. (Lifting boxes will be an infrequent activity.)
- As applicable to the work performed, will be knowledgeable about and actively support culturally competent recovery based practices, person centered planning as a shared decision making process with the individual, who defines his/her life goals and is assisted in developing a unique path toward those goals, and a trauma informed culture of safety to aid consumers in the recovery process.
