#### New Expense Contract: Mirazon

Dwight Washington wondered if this storage would be enough for expansion over the next 3-5 years. Joanne said we purchased this amount of storage with that intent. She said discussions on expanding storage/removing data that isn't needed is constantly monitored.

Sara Lurie presented Dr. Stanley's items in her absence. This renewal is for CEI to purchase psychiatric services from Michigan State University for the period of October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022 and pay \$200/hour for those services for up to 20 hours/week.

# Expense Contract Renewals: Meridian Professional Psychological Consultants, PC and Professional Psychological and Rehabilitation Services, PC

Dwight asked about the ECT and wondered if it was a popular treatment? Sara said she wouldn't say it was popular, but it can help those who have tried other methods without success. Raul said ECT hasn't changed much in the last 20 years, and it isn't a practice for everybody, but it can help quality of life.

# **Expense Contract Renewal: Michael Gomez**

Gwenda Summers presented this renewal with Michael Gomez to provide training and coaching in Trauma Focused-Cognitive Behavioral Therapy to CMHSP's and pay up to \$33,300 for those services for the period of October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022.

Revenue Contract Renewal: Michigan Department of Health and Human
Services (MDHHS) – Mental Health and Juvenile Justice Federal Block Grant
Gwenda said this contract is with MDHHS, whereas CEI provides trauma training throughout the state. She said this contract targets youth who have experienced trauma.

#### Revenue Contract Renewal: Mid-State Health Network

Sara presented these items in KC Brown's absence. She said there has been a change in the contract with MSHN; the re-entry programs will now be paid through fee for service. Sara said without a doubt, outpatient and the Recovery Center wouldn't survive on a fee for service model. With re-entry, there is concern because of the pressure to shift to fee for service. CEI tries to resist every year, but will be going this route this year.

Revenue Contract Renewal: Ingham County, Office of Community Corrections
This contract renewal renews the contract with the Michigan Department of Health
and Human Services for the mental health/juvenile justice initiative funding for
which CMHA-CEI will receive \$94,331 for the period of October 1, 2021 through
September 30, 2022 for these services.

## Preliminary Steady State Budget Projections for Fiscal Year 2021/2022

Amy Rottman reminded the committee that the budget assumptions were shared with this group about eight weeks ago. Since then, Directors and Accounting have put together a preliminary steady state budget. We have since also received information from the State and MSHN regarding revenue projections for FY22. The draft from Milliman has been considered in these projections, along with the enrollment numbers from 2020 and 2021. Enrollment is expected to decrease in December when individuals are required to reenroll in Medicaid. Looking at the Medicaid line in the preliminary budget, this is the largest change from the budget last year.

In reviewing expenses, Amy said additional calculations have been built into that side of the budget. A 3% increase has been built into the budget for staff. In addition, 8% has been built in for fringe benefits, and 3% for contracted providers. Amy noted the State is currently funding the DCW of \$2.25/hr. This has also been built into the budget. Currently, it's unclear whether this will be funded directly through the State. There is a possibility this will be approved; it is currently in the budget the Senate is reviewing. This would provide CEI with additional revenue, as well. With additional revenue, there is a need to continue to invest in contract providers. At this time, there is an approximate \$1.6M surplus; Directors are reviewing this and evaluating needs for program proposals.

Amy reviewed the allocation of budget variance among each program's budget. She then broke out the administration portions of the budget (approximately \$237,000 across all cost centers). The next steps are to get program proposals from Directors, so that this information can be presented to the Budget Development Advisory Group in September, and subsequently presented to the Finance Committee in September, as well.

# Medicaid Revenue Update

Amy Rottman presented the update through July. This is very reflective of what was mentioned earlier regarding the increase seen in 2021 because of increased enrollment. Numbers are historically high. Through July, the payments received are higher than the budgeted numbers by about \$20M. Projecting through the end of the fiscal year, this number will likely end up around \$24M. Directors are looking at ways to use this money before the time comes to have to return some/any of the money to MSHN. Kay asked about the ways in which the dollars may be used, and whether there is a time limit on using the dollars? Amy said yes, the dollars have to

be used before the end of the fiscal year. Sara noted that requests from one-time expenses will likely be brought directly to the Board meeting, including a possible retention payment to CEI's provider network. Directors are very concerned about retaining the provider network. There are also a number of facility expenses that may be able to be handled with the surplus. Sara said there will also be a discussion with the Board regarding an additional MERS contribution again this year. With the MERS contribution, there is always a general fund portion to this as well. Sara reminded the group we have to follow Medicaid rules in using these dollars, as well.

## **Unfinished Business:**

Kay wanted to revisit the subject about the State waivers that was discussed at last month's meeting. Sara had said the State association would be the place to bring this up, and Kay did just that. Bob Sheehan said there is something the State is doing to seek such a waiver. Kay said we may want to have an advocacy resolution at the Board level regarding this. Another point she raised in the meeting was that some states only suspend and do not terminate Medicaid when a person is incarcerated, and Bob Sheehan indicated Michigan is one of those states, but there seems to be a lack of communication to those incarcerated regarding the status of their Medicaid.

#### **New Business:**

Tim asked for an update on the CFO search. Sara said we have three candidates scheduled for first round interviews. CEI has also started working with Hiring Solutions here in town to have candidates screened prior to any interviews with CEI.
