Previous Meeting Minutes:

MOVED by Kay Randolph-Back and SUPPORTED by Dwight Washington that the Board of Directors of Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton and Ingham Counties (CMHA-CEI) approve the August 19, 2021 meeting minutes with the following amendments:

• to purchase laptop computers from Dell Computer and pay \$104,678.50

Adoption of Agenda:

Discussion:

Kay Randolph-Back expressed excitement and acknowledged the addition of the OBRA acronym (PASARR) on the Agenda, which stands for Pre-Admission Screening and Annual Resident Reviews.

ACTION:

MOVED by Kay Randolph-Back and SUPPORTED by Dwight Washington that the Board of Directors of Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton and Ingham Counties (CMHA-CEI) approve the September 16, 2021, Agenda as written.

<u>Public Comment</u>: None.

Mid-State Health Network (MSHN) Update:

Board Chair, Joe Brehler reported that the Mid-State Health Network Board of Directors met. Areas of focus:

- Budget reporting \$34 million dollars in revenue over expenses
- Strategic Plan Mr. Brehler advised that he voted against the strategic plan for two reasons: a. it is clear that at some point, MSHN will change their bylaws to allow partnership with the health plans and change the purpose of why PHIPs were established and b. concerned that at one point will become FFS due to the overarching goal of better equity which equates to cheaper services.
- DCW Mid-State voted to continue benefit.
- Medicaid Requirements Suspended All requirements have been suspended through March 31, 2022, which is the main source of unexpected funds.
- 2019 Reconciliation, it appears that they owe us \$800,000, not sure of the timeline to spend the funds.

ACTION: Amy Rottman will research and send out a follow-up email to the board.

Board Member, Kay Randolph-Back inquired as to how the Consumer Advisory Councils fit in as consumers would be affected, and asked whether they contribute to discussion? Mr. Brehler advised that to date the Consumer Advisory Councils have not been included in discussion to his knowledge.

Mr. Brehler commended Sara Lurie and the Directors Group staff on all the work that has been done through the COVID-19 pandemic with the implementation of the Connect system, CCBHC state demonstration grant, telehealth, etc. Everyone has worked above and beyond and he is very proud to represent CMHA-CEI as board Chair. He is hoping that next fiscal year, we will see more funds available and looks forward to being able to adequately plan.

CEO Report

CEO, Sara Lurie announced that Suzanne (Sue) Panetta will be joining CMHA-CEI as the new Chief Financial Officer. Sue's first day will be on Monday, September 27, 2021. Sue's background is in accounting and she brings experience working as Finance Director and Chief Financial Officer in several non-profit healthcare settings. Special acknowledgment from Board Chair, Joe Brehler, as he expressed gratefulness and thankfulness to Joanne Holland, CIO, Pam Flory, Reimbursement Supervisor, and Amy Rottman, Rehmann Robson consultant for performing admirably in the absence of a CFO since May, 2021 and taking the steps necessary to make improvements and oversee operations of our Finance Department. Joanne, Pam and Amy will continue to be involved as well as the entire Finance Department during Sue's orientation period.

Highlights from the CEO Report included:

• Vaccination Mandates

Raul Gonzales expressed concern that we do not have a network in place to support vaccination and inquired about an effort to get our staff vaccinated. Sara Lurie advised that we are doing a lot (i.e. due to the efforts of the Virus Task Force, the Ingham County mobile will be on site at Walk-A-Mile offering vaccinations), but agreed that we need to do more as the numbers are not where we would like for them to be at this time.

Dwight Washington inquired as to whether we are doing anything for testing for antibodies. Sara Lurie advised that we are not, however, is aware that Sparrow has something in place.

- Ingham County Board of Commissioners Resolution #21-493 Commissioner Emily Stivers mentioned that she has concerns for CMHA-CEI if the vendor policy is passed and invited anyone who would like to speak to attend. The resolution would require meeting or exceeding a rate at or above 60% for all Ingham County vendors. Not sure at this time if there will be a testing option. The meeting will take place next Tuesday at 6pm at the Ingham Human Services Building.
- Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics Kickoff Training scheduled for Monday, September 20 and Tuesday, September 21. Dale Copedge expressed interest in tracking of data, Sara Lurie advised that we are unable track everything, but we are tracking as much as we can and advised that for the expansion grant as of July 30th we are reflecting significant improvements and better results for both pre and post numbers.

• Senate Government Operations Hearing Testimonies scheduled for the Tuesday, September 21 from 1 – 3 (Shirkey Integration bill#597)

Maxine Thome has a written testimony, which is excellent and Joe Brehler and Dianne Holman have requested to testify. Paul Palmer, Linda Matson and Jeri Nicole Wright have pre-recorded testimonies that have been submitted by CMHAM. We've noticed that the consumer component has been truly bias to cast doubt on whether the current system can achieve integration.

ACTION: Sara Lurie sent out an email to the Advocacy Team, but will send it out to the full board.

*On rare occasions, consumers may be admitted to the hospital who require substantially higher amounts of one to one staffing than is typical, due to highly aggressive or self-injurious behavior. Payor shall prior authorize up to two days Enchanted Staffing Inpatient Psychiatric Services for Consumers in this situation on a case by case basis. Criteria for Enhanced Staff Inpatient Psychiatric Services are as follows:

1. The Consumer must meet all of the Inpatient Admission Certification Criteria listed above (Diagnosis, Severity of Illness, and Intensity of Service).

2. The Consumer is failing at least restrictive placement despite active treatment, with no exceptions of improvement in a timely manner, combined with risk factors to Customers or Hospital such as:

Swallowing behavior on unit, aggression towards others, and/or extreme property destruction at such a level that Consumer requires constant attention from staff in order to prevent self-harm, harm others, or extreme property destruction

Public Comment

Daniel Arnold shared expressed that he has come a long way in his recovery since March 2019 and thanked CMHA-CEI for the services provided. Additionally, Daniel shared a copy of his book entitled: You can have what you want. His daily goal is to encourage people with severe mental illness and keep advocating.

Linda Matson thanked the board for putting a Consumer Advisory Council in place at CEI and shared that it is a great privilege to be part of the council. Additionally, Ms. Matson shared that she has been on the CAC since its inception and reiterated the importance of advocacy right now. She shared that she and other members of CAC have pre-recorded videos through CMHAM which may be used and that she plans to continue to reach out to the newspaper and share her story as well as continue to write letters of support for the public mental health system services which are invaluable.

Nathan (Luna) Brown expressed that there is a problem with the current system as it

is divided in three: MI, DD and Substance Abuse. The MI consumer gets a therapist. However, if you are on the DD side, you do not get a therapist assigned and substance abuse consumers mental illness goes unaddressed stating that it has been over one year without a therapist. He then inquired about the lack of structure referring to HCBS community setting and no adequate replacement with the exception of Community Groups.
