Expense Contract Expansion: Residential Type A Contracts

Shana Badgley presented an expansion for a long-standing contract. A consumer needed to be moved into the home quickly, which is why there are retro rates attached. Kay Randolph-Back asked a question about Home and Community Based Rules. This home is not segregated, and she was wondering if this provides CMH with an advantage in already being compliant. Shana relayed that this isn't a new practice, and there are several homes that have historically chosen to be non-segregated.

ACTION:

MOVED by Kam Washburn and SUPPORTED by Chris Swope that the Finance Committee recommends that the Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, and Ingham Counties Board of Directors authorize CMHA-CEI to expand the roster of homes of the contract with Joy Mbelu to purchase residential services with the per diem rates of \$32.59 (Level I), \$52.89 (Level II), and \$73.20 (Level III) for the period of April 1, 2018 through September 30, 2018.

Stacia Chick provided an update on the FY17 audit. The audit was due on April 2nd, but is currently not complete. Plante Moran said they will have a draft to CEI by next week at the latest. There are two outstanding issues Plante Moran is currently working on; they need more documentation to further substantiate these items. Stacia stated that different items are looked at each year, as is required by law. Discussion ensued about questions coming up right before the audit is due, and Stacia shared there wasn't enough time between the last audit and this year's audit for questions to be answered.
