## COVID-19 Vaccination Availability

Information about COVID-19 vaccination availability is changing regularly. As we learn of new locations in our community that provide vaccinations, we'll continue to provide updates to you in this newsletter. It is recommended that anyone interested in getting vaccinated complete the registration process to express their interest in as many venues as possible and, when notified of availability, accept a vaccination appointment from only one provider.

### Area Vaccine Resources:

- **Meijer:** Meijer has partnered with the State of Michigan to help administer COVID-19 vaccines. Anyone can pre-register for the COVID-19 vaccine with Meijer and they will notify you if they are able to provide you with the vaccine. - **Sparrow:** This week Sparrow announced they will begin distributing the COVID-19 vaccine at the Sparrow Laboratories Drive-Thru Services site at Frandor. Learn how to register for a vaccine with Sparrow on their website: <https://www.sparrow.org/vaccine> Keep checking for available appointments: The extent and frequency of the public distribution will be dependent on the weekly supply of doses that Sparrow receives from the government. Sparrow will schedule clinics based on the weekly allotment they receive.
- **Ingham County Health Department:** Anyone who lives or works in Ingham County can register with the health department to express their interest in receiving a vaccine. Complete the registration form here: [Click to register](#). When there is availability, ICHD will email you a link to schedule an appointment.
- **Barry-Eaton Health Department:** Anyone who lives or works in Eaton County can register with the health department to express their interest in receiving a vaccine. Complete the interest form here: [Click to complete](#) BEHD will then provide you with information to schedule an appointment if one is available. They will also save your contact information and send you notifications by e-mail when new appointments are added.
- **Mid-Michigan District Health Department:** If you live or work in Clinton County you can schedule a vaccination appointment with MMDHD. You may need to check the link regularly to see if they have added more available slots. Find scheduling information here: [Click to view](#).
